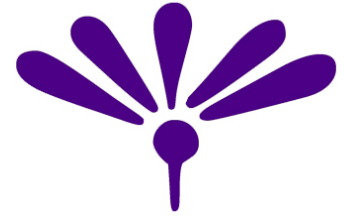


Lent 2023



Lenten Bible reading plan – From the Gospel of Mark

Week 1

Day 1 Mark 1:1-20 John the Baptist prepares the way, The baptism and testing of Jesus, Jesus announces the good news, Jesus calls his first disciples.

Day 2 Mark 1:21-39 Jesus drives out an impure spirit, Jesus heals many, Jesus prays in a solitary place.

Day 3 Mark 1:40-2:12 Jesus heals a man with leprosy, Jesus forgives and heals a paralyzed man.

Day 4 Mark 2:13-28 Jesus calls Levi and eats with sinners, Jesus question about fasting, Jesus is Lord of the Sabbath.

Week 2

Day 5 Mark 3:1-19 Jesus heals on the Sabbath, Crowds follow Jesus, Jesus appoints the Twelve.

Day 6 Mark 3:20-35 Jesus is accused by his family and by teachers of the law.

Day 7 Mark 4:1-20 The parable of the sower.

Day 8 Mark 4:21-34 A lamp on a stand, The parable of the growing seed, The parable of the mustard seed.

Day 9 Mark 4:35–5:20 Jesus calms the storm, Jesus restores a demon-possessed man.

Day 10 Mark 5:21-34 Jesus raises a dead girl and heals a sick woman.

Week 3

Day 11 Mark 5:35–6:6 A Prophet without honor.

Day 12 Mark 6:7-29 Jesus sends out the twelve, and John the Baptist is beheaded.

Day 13 Mark 6:30-44 Jesus feeds the five thousand.

Day 14 Mark 6:45-56 Jesus walks on water.

Day 15 Mark 7:1-23 That which defiles.

Day 16 Mark 7:24-37 Jesus honors a Syrophenician Women's Faith, Jesus heals a deaf and mute man.

Week 4

Day 17 Mark 8:1-21 Jesus feeds the four thousand, The yeast of the Pharisees and Herod.

Day 18 Mark 8:22-33 Jesus heals a blind man at Bethesda, Peter declares that Jesus is the Messiah, Jesus predicts his own death.

Day 19 Mark 8:34-9:13 The way of the Cross, The Transfiguration.

Day 20 Mark 9:14-29 Jesus heals a boy possessed by an impure spirit.

Day 21 Mark 9:30-37 Jesus predicts his death a second time.

Day 22 Mark 9:38-50 Whoever is not against us is for us, causing to stumble.

Week 5

Day 23 Mark 10:1-16 Divorce, the little children with Jesus.

Day 24 Mark 10:17-31 The rich in the kingdom of God.

Day 25 Mark 10:32-46 Jesus predicts his death a third time, the request of James and John, blind Bartimaeus receives his sight.

Day 26 Mark 11:1-25 Jesus comes to Jerusalem as king, Jesus curses a fig tree and clears the temple courts.

Day 27 Mark 11:27-12:12 The authority of Jesus is questioned. The parable of the tenants.

Day 28 Mark 12:13-34 Paying the imperial tax to Caesar, Marriage at the resurrection. The greatest commandment.

Week 6

Day 29 Mark 12:35-44 Who's son is the Messiah? Warning against the teachers of the law. The widow's offering.

Day 30 Mark 13:1-20 The destruction of the temple and signs of the end times.

Day 31 Mark 13:21-37 The end times, The day and the hour is unknown.

Day 32 Mark 14:1-26 Jesus is anointed, Bethany, and The Last Supper.

Day 33 Mark 14:27-42 Jesus predicts Peter's denial, Gethsemane.

Day 34 Mark 14:43-65 Jesus is arrested Jesus before the Sanhedrin.

Week 7

Day 35 Mark 14:66-15:15 Peter disowned Jesus, Jesus before Pilate.

Day 36 Mark 15:16-39 The soldiers mock Jesus, The death of Jesus.

Day 37 Mark 15:40-47 The burial of Jesus.

Day 38 Mark 16:1-8 Jesus has Risen.

Day 39 Mark 16:9-14 Jesus appeared to Mary and others.

Day 40 Mark 16:15-20 Jesus appeared to the eleven, Jesus taken up to Heaven and sat at the right hand of God
