

- 1** Give thanks for how God loves you, no matter what.
...give thanks to Him and praise His name for the Lord is good, and his love endures forever, his faithfulness continues through all generations. Psalm 100:4-5
- 2** Pray for people who are sick.
He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. Psalm 147:3
- 3** Give thanks for this beautiful world. God's creation given to us.
For by Him, all things were created, in heaven, and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominion or rulers or authorities, all things were created through him and for Him. Colossians 1:16
- 4** Ask God to grow your relationship with Him.
But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength they will soar high on wings like eagles, they will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint. Isaiah 40:31
- 5** Sincerely ask God for forgiveness, for something you should not have done, said, or thought.
But if we confess our sins, God will forgive us. We can trust God to do this. He always does what is right. He will make us clean from all the wrong things we have done. 1 John 1:9
- 6** Ask God to help you make good choices throughout your day.
For I know the plans I have for you: declares the Lord "Plans to prosper you, and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future" Jeremiah 29:11
- 7** Ask God to help you with a difficult thing that you need to do.
Don't worry about anything, but pray and ask God for everything you need, always giving thanks for what you have. 7 And because you belong to Christ Jesus, God's peace will stand guard over all your thoughts and feelings. His peace can do this far better than our human minds.
- 8** Pray for people in need, when you see them on the news or in person.
Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality. Romans 12:12-13
- 9** Ask God to help you rely on him in all that you do. In good times and difficult times.
I have told you these things that in me, you may have peace. In this world, you will have trouble but take heart. I have overcome the world. John 16:33
- 10** Praise God for all the things that make you delighted!
Be joyful, always, pray continuously, and give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

- 11** Pray for all the teachers and staff in our schools.
Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:58
- 12** Pray for everyone to be safe.
The Lord watches over you — the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord will keep you from all harm — he will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore. Psalm 121:5-8
- 13** Ask God to bring good friends into your life.
Whoever walks with the wise becomes wise, but the companion of fools will suffer harm. Proverbs 13:20
- 14** Ask God to help you be more generous with your time & money.
Tell those who are rich to do good—to be rich in good works. And tell them they should be happy to give and ready to share. 1 Timothy 6:18
- 15** Forgive someone that hurt you.
...be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other just as Christ God forgave you. Ephesians 4:32
- 16** Ask God to give you strength against temptations. Name some of your temptations.
The only temptations that you have are the same temptations that all people have. But you can trust God. He will not let you be tempted more than you can bear. But when you are tempted, God will also give you a way to escape that temptation. Then you will be able to endure it. 1 Corinthians 10:13
- 17** Ask God to give you the courage to do what he wants you to do.
Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified (of your enemies), for the Lord God goes with you; he will never leave you or forsake you. Deuteronomy 31:6
- 18** Pray for our Government to lead with dignity and honesty.
Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us. Titus 2:7-8
- 19** Pray to be a cheerful and generous giver.
Remember this: The one who plants few seeds will have a small harvest. But the one who plants a lot will have a big harvest. Each one of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give. You should not give if it makes you unhappy or if you feel forced to give. God loves those who are happy to give. And God can give you more blessings than you need, and you will always have plenty of everything. You will have enough to give to every good work. 2 Corinthians 9:6-8
- 20** Pray for your friends, especially those who don't know God.
Pray in the Spirit at all times. Pray with all kinds of prayers, and ask for everything you need. To do this you must always be ready. Never give up. Always pray for all of God's people. Ephesians 6:18

21 Thank the Lord for all the people who love you.

This is what I command you: Love each other as I have loved you.
John 15:12

22 Pray for our local, and world leaders. That they would be righteous.
In the Bible, righteous means living in a way that is just, honest, and faithful to God.

Pray for kings and everyone who is in authority so that we can live a quiet and peaceful life in complete godliness and dignity. 1 Timothy 2:1

23 Thank God for plants that provide food for us to eat.

And God said, "Behold, I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the face of all the earth, and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for food. Genesis 1:29

24 Ask God to show you how to share your faith with others.

Go into all the world and preach the good news to everyone.
Matthew 28:19

25 Ask God for help to listen carefully. To stop and pray before responding, especially if you are feeling angry.

Know this, my beloved brothers: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger James 1:19

26 Express gratitude for the people in your life who have helped you along your way.

Whatever happens, always be thankful. This is how God wants you to live in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

27 Pray for our Church leaders everywhere.

Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God.
Hebrews 13:7

28 Ask God to direct your attention to what He needs you to do.

And we know that in all things, God works for the good of those who love him who have been called according to his purpose. Romans 8:28

29 Pray for an end to people's suffering throughout the world.

Let us hold unwaveringly to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful. Hebrews 10:23

30 Thank God for sending Jesus and allowing forgiveness for our sins.

In him (Jesus) we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace. Ephesians 1:6-7

31 Ask God to help you trust Him with all your heart.

Trust in the Lord, with all of your heart, and lean, not on your own understanding. Proverbs 3:5

32 Give thanks for the many things we often take for granted—food, shelter, meals, loved ones, and our health.

Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Jesus Christ. 1 Thessalonians 5:18

33 What kinds of temptations do you struggle with? Ask God for help overcoming these temptations.

I can do all things through Him who gives me strength. Philippians 4:13

34 Give thanks to God for his love is with you at all times.

Give thanks to Him and praise His name for the Lord is good and his love endures forever. His faithfulness continues through all generations.

35 Ask God to help you make wise choices throughout your day.

Be very careful then, how you live, not as unwise, but as wise, making the most out of every opportunity because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:15-16

36 Thank God for people who volunteer. Take a moment to name some of the volunteers that you know.

How can we thank God enough for you in return for all the joy we have in the presence of our God because of you? 1 Thessalonians 3:9

37 Thank God for the people whose work it is to serve and help us. Take a moment to list as many as you can think of.

Whatever you do, in word or deed do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving things through Him to God, the Father. Colossians 3:1:7

38 Pray for guidance in learning to love those people you struggle to understand.

Live a life of love. Love others just as Christ loved us. He gave himself for us—a sweet-smelling offering and sacrifice to God. Ephesians 5:1-2

39 Pray the Lord's prayer slowly. Consider the meaning of each sentence.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread and forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who have sinned against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Matthew 6:9-13

40 Consider what faith means and thank the Lord for always being with you.
